the bluebird when you are alone.*

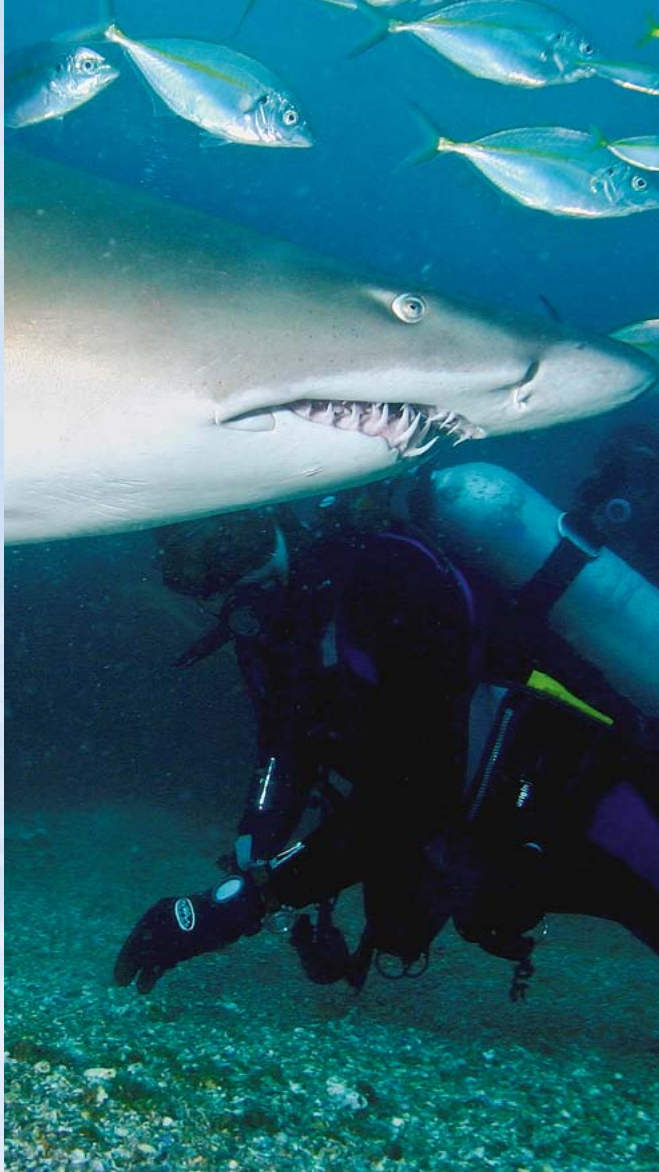


Recently, many catchers appeared who think that catching the bluebird is difficult – easier to catch a blue fish. However, there are plenty of “hidden rocks” in that case.

likes these things very much!*

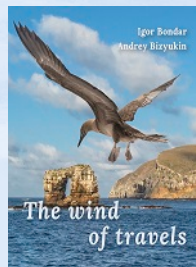
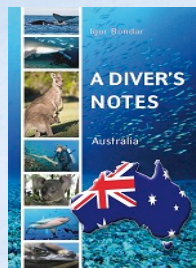
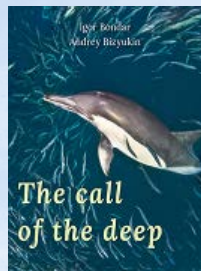
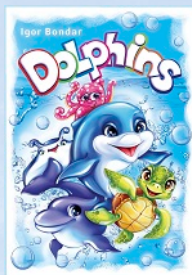
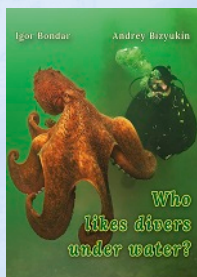
