let me relax in the jacuzzi?”*

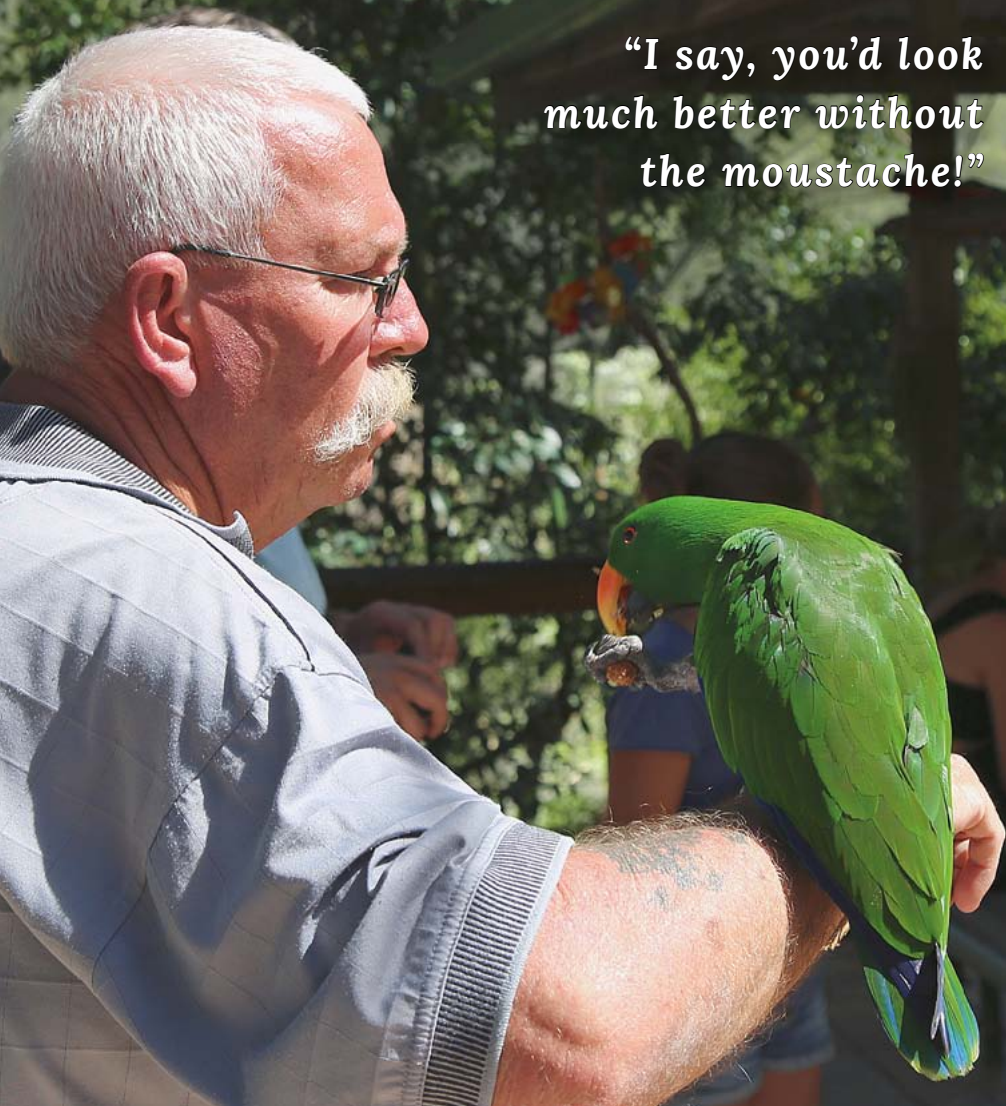


Don't interrupt me, tree!"

never be able to dance like this.”*

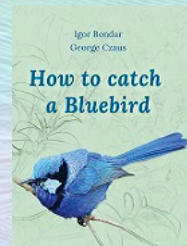
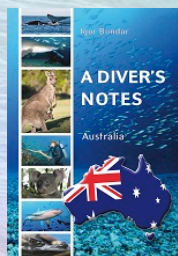
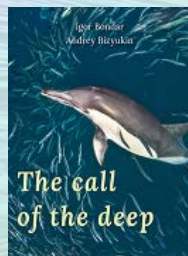
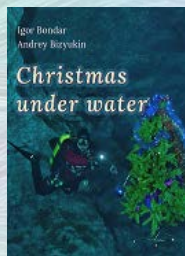



