are part of something much bigger.*



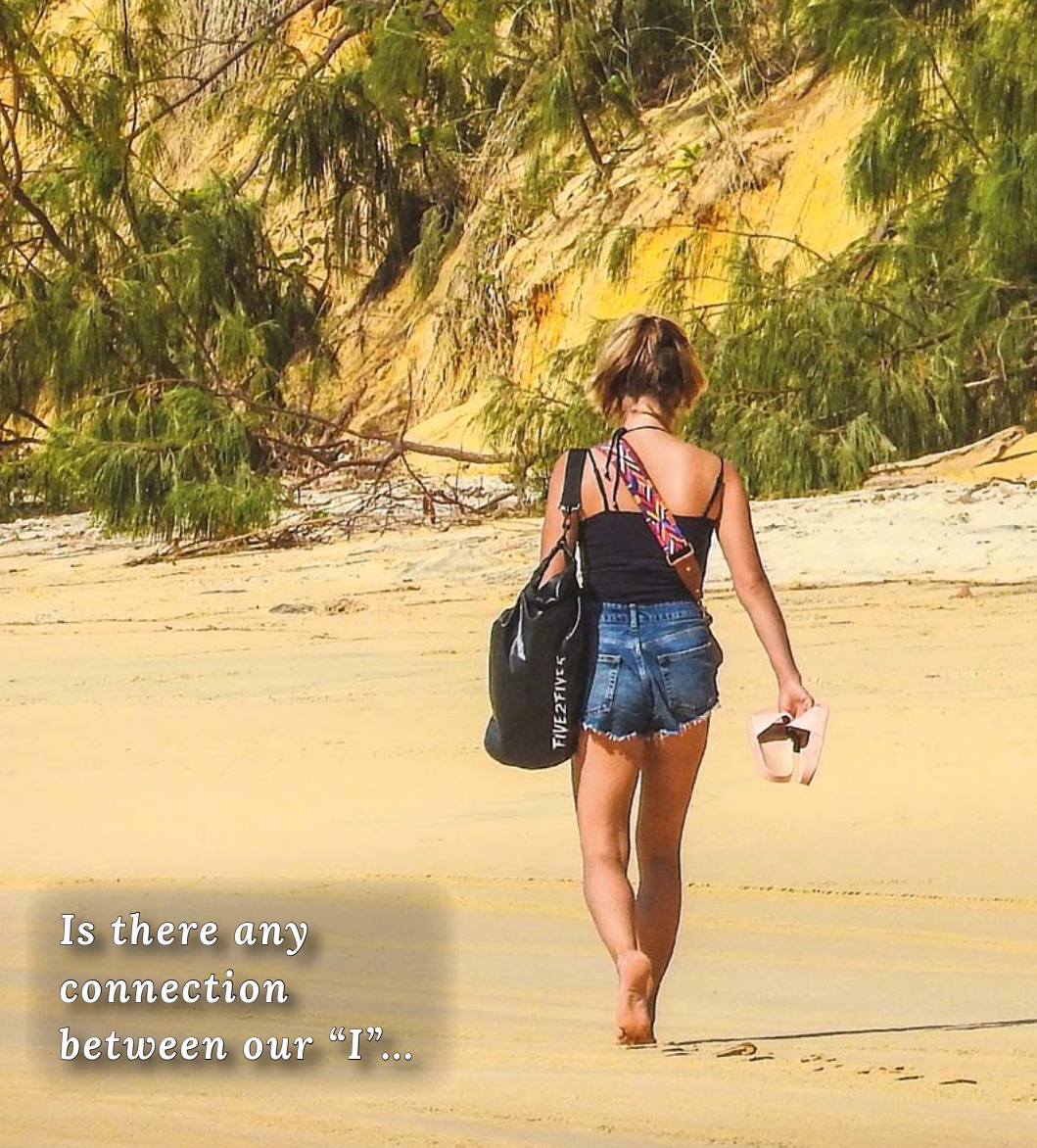


*Why is that? Why do we often seek

“row” in different directions.*



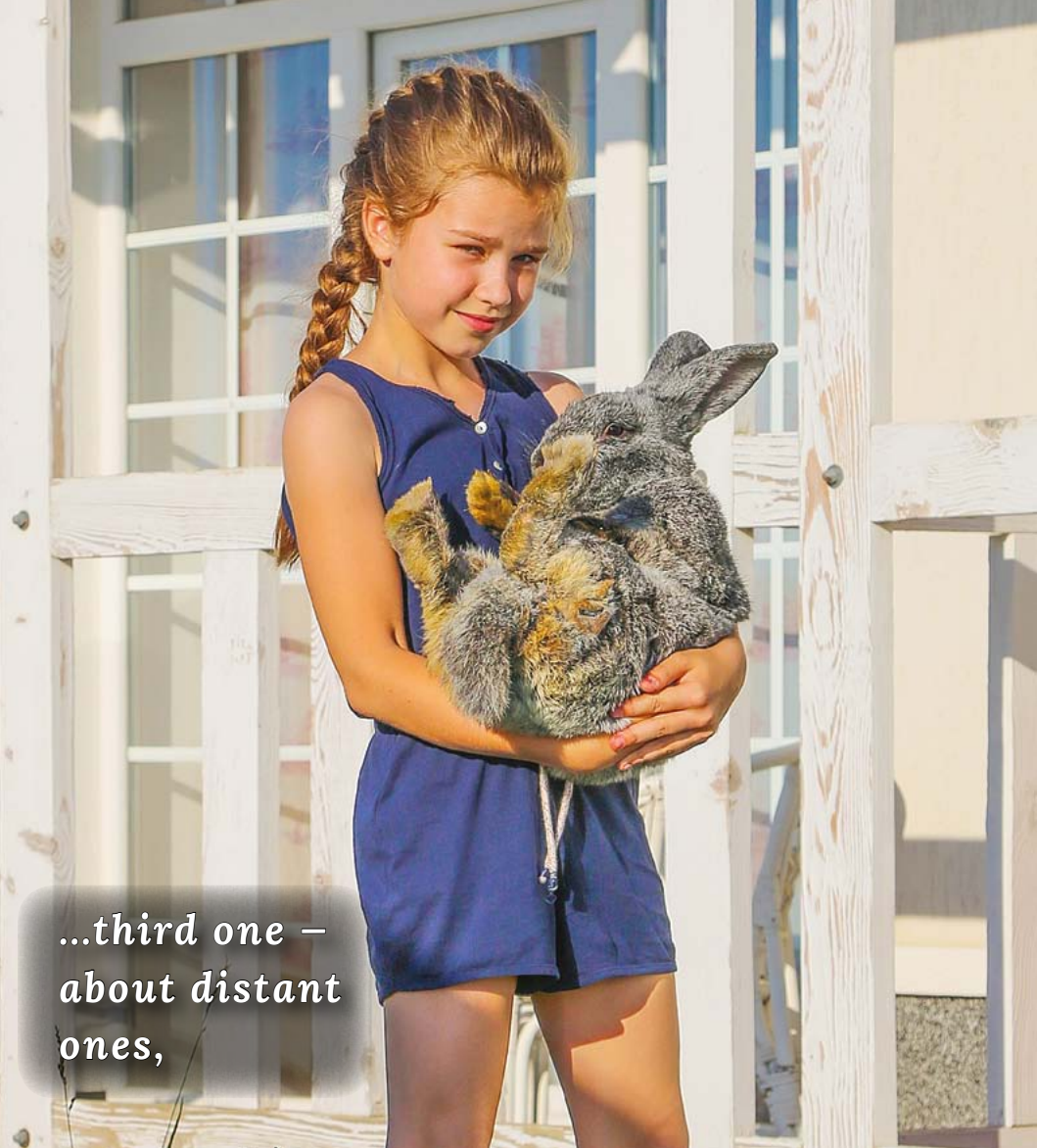


*For example, one our part

of our toys).



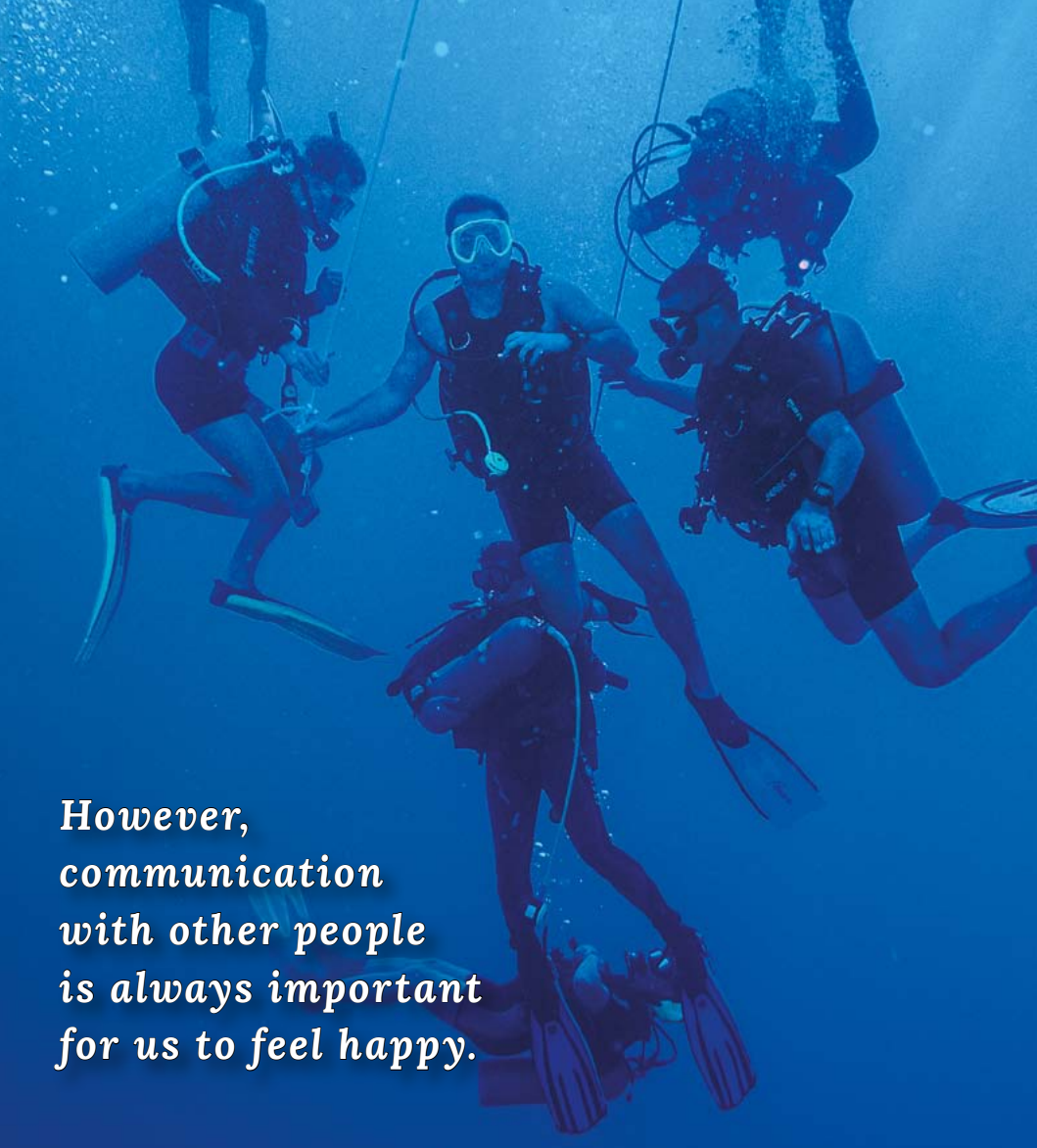
*But our “we” can be much broader.*



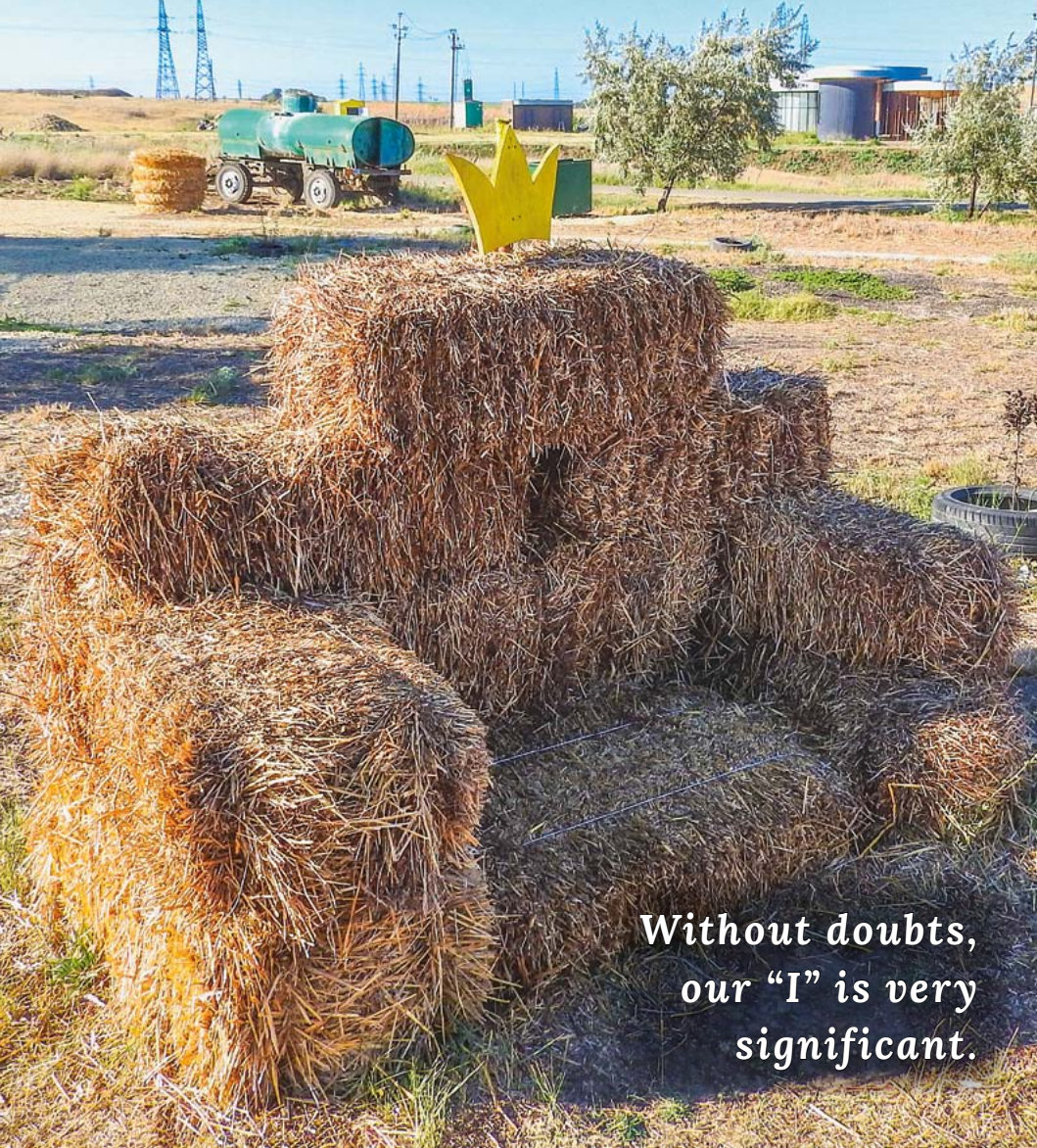


*Individuality, for sure,

can think about something.*



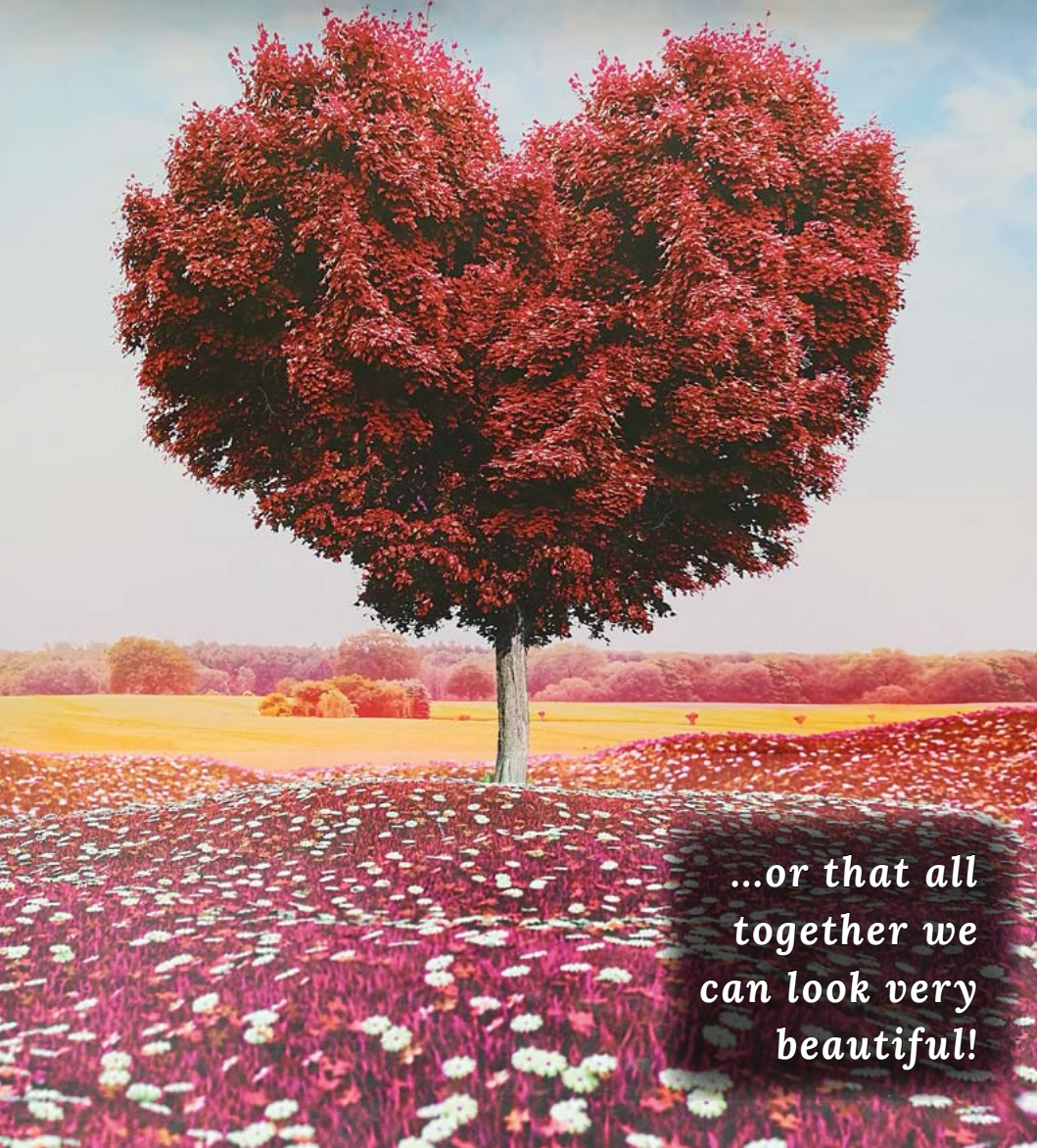


*For example, to think that “two”

beautiful!*

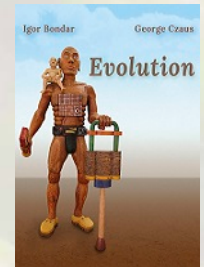
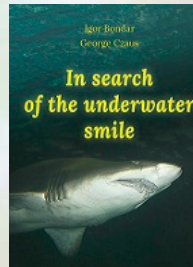
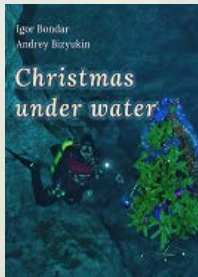
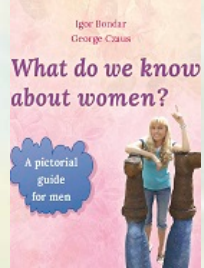
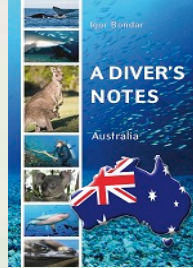
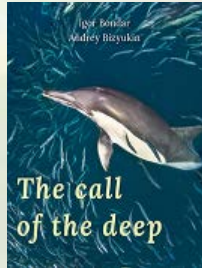
