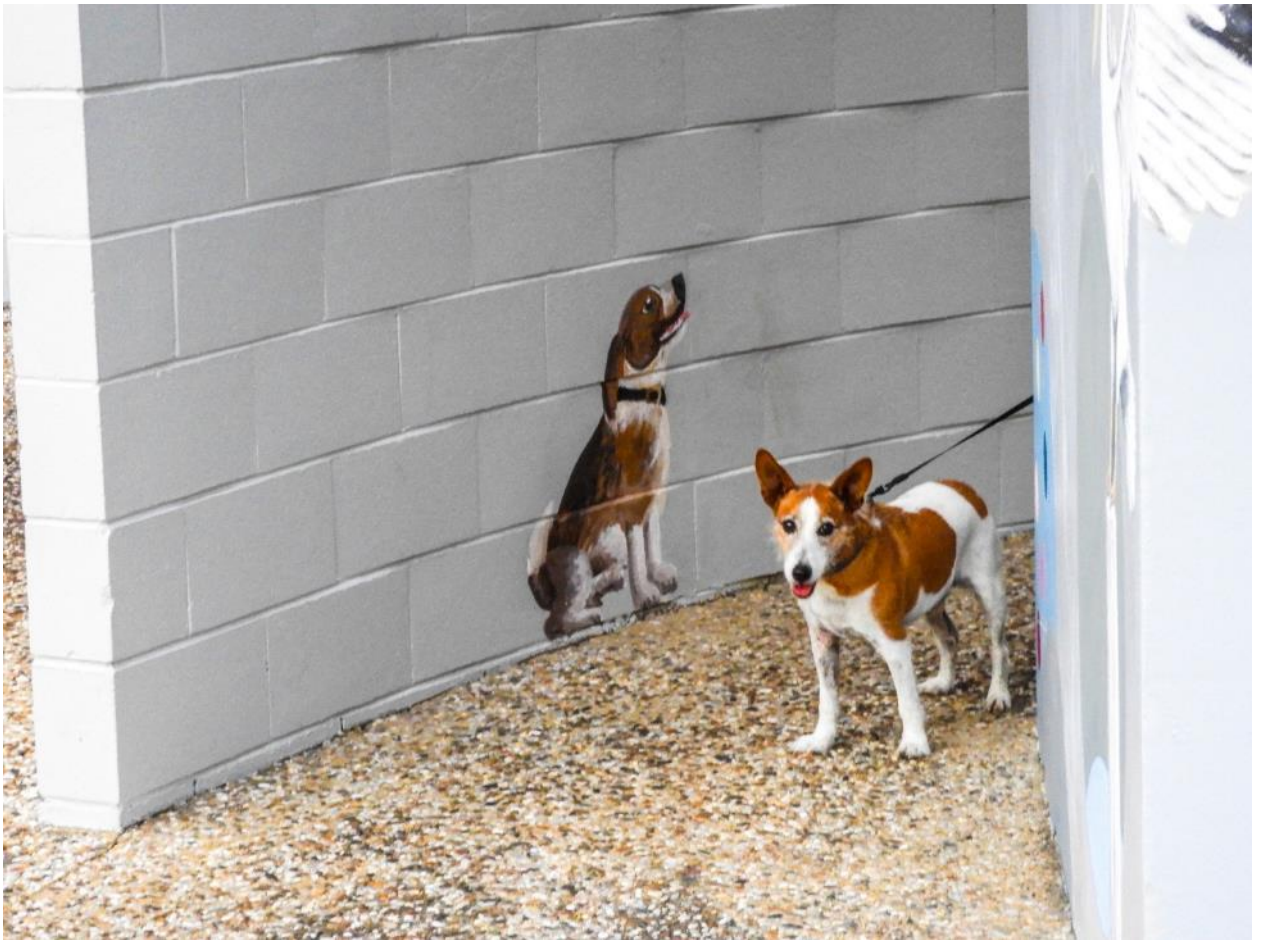
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Photo 4 thoughts

Many on this Earth like to take interest in things they absolutely do not need.



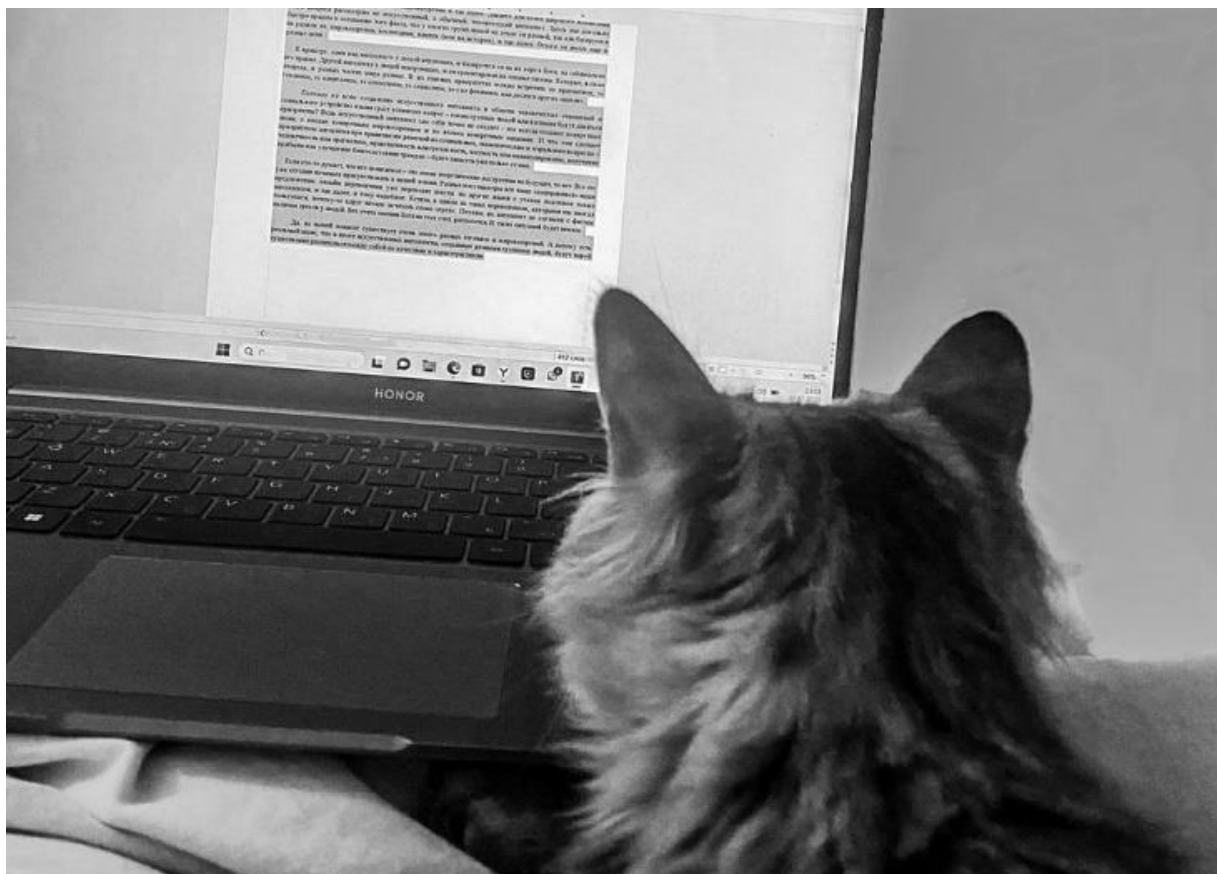
Our expectations of a relationship and the relationship itself are sometimes very different things. What can be said here – sometimes there is also an abyss between God's expectations from people and reality.
