the bluebird when you are alone.*



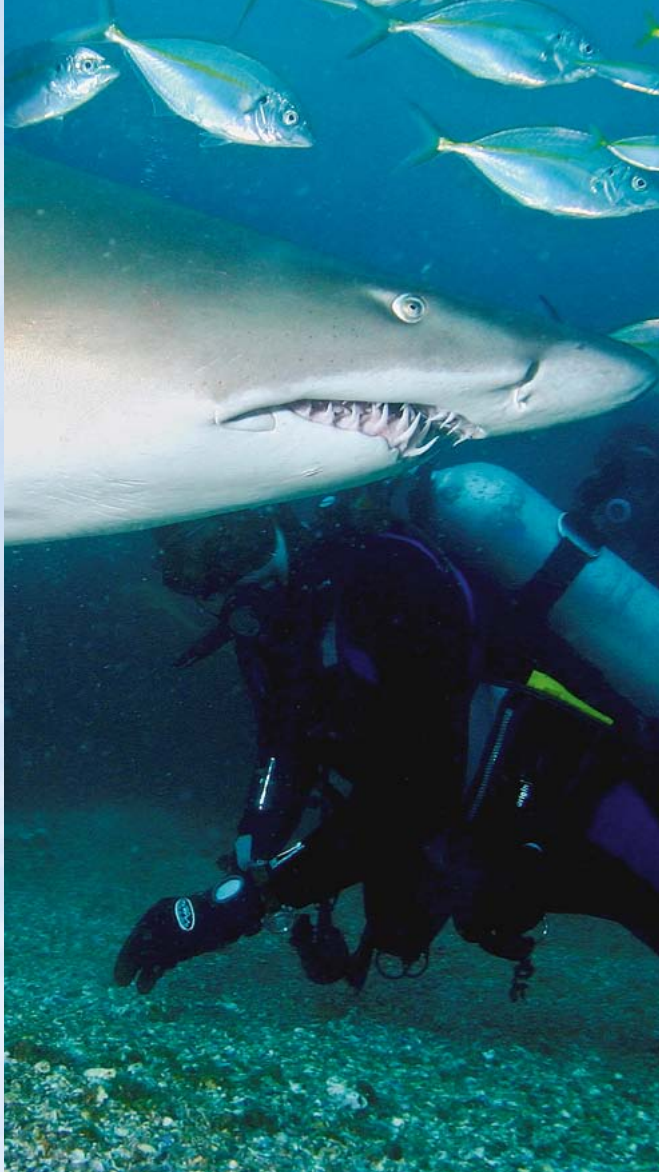
Recently there have appeared many catchers,

likes these things very much!*

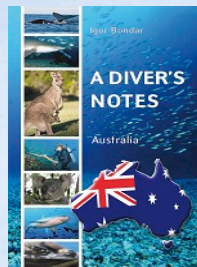
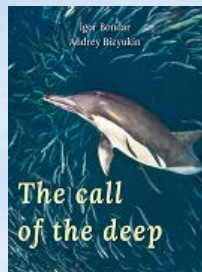
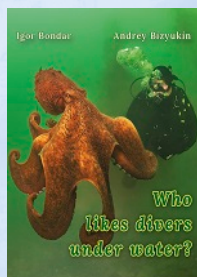
*And the Bluebird itself flies
